

Redistricting Maps

The County Council approved an amended version of Bill 55-25 at the legislative session on September 15th by a vote of 5-2. This bill expands the number of councilmanic districts from seven to nine. The new councilmanic district boundaries approved in Bill 55-25 will be effective for the 2026 County Council elections. 

SVDP Eastside Shelter is a 236-bed shelter, offering essential resources and a safe, supportive environment for families, single women, and single men who are facing homelessness, helping them regain stability and secure permanent housing as quickly as possible.

In addition, the support services and programs they offer include: workshops, case management, housing and job search assistance, and child development and recreational activities.

MD 45 (York Road) Roadway Improvements and Water Main Replacement Project

The State Highway Administration (SHA) and the Baltimore County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPWT), is beginning the construction phase of the MD 45 (York Road) Roadway Improvements and Water Main Replacement Project in Towson. The 0.5-mile project extends along York Rd from Newell Ave to the Towson Roundabout.

The purpose of the \$9 million joint project is to replace the county water main under York Road and upgrade the roadway, sidewalks, driveway entrances and drainage inlets and pipes along 0.5-mile of York Road to improve highway safety and traffic operations, pedestrian accommodations and bicycle connections.

SHA, Baltimore County DPWT and contractor Pessoa Construction Co. will make every effort to complete this project as quickly as possible while minimizing impacts on residents, businesses and travelers. Weather and other construction factors permitting, the project will be complete by fall 2027.
