1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 3 of Bill 6-24 is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with
3	amendments and Section 4 is hereby added to Bill 6-24, to read as follows:

8	Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted, that [this Act shall take effect 45 days after its
9	enactment.] THE LIMITATION ON THE SQUARE FOOTAGE OF AN ACCESSORY
10	STRUCTURE IN §32-8-507(A) OF THIS ACT SHALL NOT APPLY TO A PERMIT OR A
11	PETITION FOR VARIANCE FOR SUCH A STRUCTURE FILED PRIOR TO THE
12	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, NOR SHALL IT APPLY TO ANY SUBSEQUENT
13	PERMIT OR PETITION FOR VARIANCE FOR THE SAME STRUCTURE FILED
14	SUBSEQUENT TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT BUT PRIOR TO NOVEMBER 1
15	2025.

17	SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE
18	EFFECT 45 DAYS AFTER ITS ENACTMENT.

20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
21	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect 14 days from the
22	date of its enactment.
