9	5. The following additional uses in the Pikesville Design Review Area along
10	Church Lane, AND IN THE LIBERTY ROAD (EAST) COMMERCIAL REVITALIZATION
11	DISTRICT WITHIN INTERSTATE 695 AND ROLLING ROAD:
12	a. Personal service establishments, including barber shops, [and] beauty
13	shops, AND PERSONAL DAY SPAS, with accessory retail sales.
14	b. Accessory showroom and sales, including accessory storage.
15	c. Accessory day and overnight parking for passenger or business
16	vehicles, including cars, vans, and pick-up trucks, subject to reasonable screening with
17	landscaping or fencing from a public street or abutting residentially zoned property.

19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
20	the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect 14 days after its
21	enactment.
