FOR the purpose of amending the 2025-2026 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the General Fund monies derived from unexpended and unencumbered General Fund balance.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 712 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may make additional appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the county budget, or from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the federal government was shut down on October 1, 2025, and has announced numerous layoffs of federal employees, non-payment of wages to certain federal employees, and the termination of SNAP and other benefits to recipients; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland has declared a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the continuation of the federal shutdown threatens lives and health in Baltimore County, requiring Baltimore County to call all of its resources into limited or long-term activation; now therefore

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE						
2	COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Section 712						
3	of the Baltimore County Charter, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June						
4	30, 2026, be and is hereby amended by appropriating unreserved, undesignated General Fund						
5	Surplus in the amount herein specified, to the following programs, to make grants to or purchase						
6	from various programs that provide food:
