A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Zoning Regulations – Uses Permitted in the M.L.R and M.L. Zones – Housing for the Elderly

FOR the purpose of permitting Housing for the Elderly as a principal use to a property located in the Manufacturing, Light, Restricted (M.L.R.) Zone and Manufacturing, Light (M.L.) Zone of a certain contiguous acreage; establishing certain bulk, area, and setback requirements for such use; establishing a limit on the number of dwelling units for such use; and generally relating to uses permitted in the M.L.R. and M.L. Zones.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations read as follows:

9 § 248.1. Permitted uses.

10 A. The following uses only are permitted:

11 14. HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY, PROVIDED THE USE IS LOCATED IN
12 AN M.L.R. ZONE WHICH IS PART OF A CONTIGUOUS AREA OF 150 ACRES OR MORE
13 OF INDUSTRIAL ZONING ~~AND THE UNITS ARE CONSTRUCTED ON A VACANT LOT ,~~
14 IS WITHIN AN EXISTING OFFICE PARK PLATTED PRIOR TO 2010 , AND IS ON A LOT
15 THAT IS NOT IMPROVED WITH AN EXISTING BUILDING. THE ONLY APPLICABLE
16 BULK AND AREA REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE AS SET FORTH IN SECTIONS 235B.3

23 Section 253 – Manufacturing, Light (M.L.) Zone Use Regulations

§ 253.1. Uses permitted as of right.

The uses listed in this section, only, shall be permitted as of right in M.L. Zones, subject to any conditions hereinafter prescribed.

M. HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY, PROVIDED THE USE IS LOCATED IN AN M.L. ZONE WHICH IS PART OF A CONTIGUOUS AREA OF 150 ACRES OR MORE OF INDUSTRIAL ZONING ~~AND THE UNITS ARE CONSTRUCTED ON A VACANT LOT~~, IS WITHIN AN EXISTING OFFICE PARK PLATTED PRIOR TO 2010 , AND IS ON A LOT THAT IS NOT IMPROVED WITH AN EXISTING BUILDING. THE ONLY APPLICABLE BULK AND AREA REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE AS SET FORTH IN SECTIONS 235B.3 THROUGH 235B.6 OF THESE REGULATIONS, AND SETBACK REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE AS SET FORTH FOR COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS IN SECTIONS 235.1 THROUGH 235.3 OF THESE REGULATIONS. ANY HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY CONSTRUCTED ON A LOT UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THIS PROVISION SHALL BE LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN 50 DWELLING UNITS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect 14 days after its enactment.
