A BILL  
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County Final Landmarks List

FOR the purpose of voting to approve or disapprove the adoption of a structure to the Final Landmarks List within 90 days after the public hearing; and generally relating to the Baltimore County Final Landmarks List.

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission has met and compiled a preliminary list of additional structures to be added to the Final Landmarks List; and

WHEREAS, the following structure has been identified on the preliminary landmarks list by the Commission and has been reviewed by the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held by the County Council on January 20, 2026, to consider whether the structure should be included on the “Final Landmarks List”; and

WHEREAS, in considering whether the following structure contributes substantially to the architectural and historical heritage of the County, State, or nation, §32-7-303(d)(1)(i) of the County Code requires the County Council to vote to approve or disapprove the adoption of a structure to the Final Landmarks List within 90 days after the public hearing; ~~now therefore~~ and

WHEREAS, the Council intends to preserve the ruins of the following structure; and

WHEREAS, the setting borders the existing Sparks Park and has been considered for use by the Department of Recreation and Parks; and

WHEREAS, the Council may adopt any structure or portion for inclusion on the Final Landmarks List; and

WHEREAS, the Council intends to adopt the Sparks School Site and Ruins to the Final Landmarks List; and

WHEREAS, the Council supports retaining the Setting as a portion of Sparks Park, for use by the Department of Recreation and Parks; now therefore

1           SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that this Act, if passed by a majority of the County Council, shall add  
3 the following new item 401 to the Final Landmarks List, to read as follows:

Final Landmarks List

The following historical landmark is hereby adopted as part of the Final Landmarks List:

No. 401. “Sparks School Site and Ruins” ~~and Setting (1.26 acres)~~, 1000 Sparks Road  
(Tax Map #0034, Parcel #0067, Tax Account ID #0802058250), Sparks

1           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Final Landmarks List shall  
2 be maintained by the Landmarks Preservation Commission in accordance with § 32-7-106 of the  
3 Baltimore County Code, 2015, as amended.

5           SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect 45 days  
6 after its enactment.
