AN ACT concerning

County Charter – Charter Review Commission – Membership – Technical Update

FOR the purpose of amending the County Charter to update the membership of the Charter Review Commission to reflect the nine Council appointments; and generally relating to the Charter Review Commission.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 1203(a)  
Article XII – Manner of Terminating this Charter and Making Amendments Thereto  
Baltimore County Charter

WHEREAS, with the approval of a ballot question by the voters of Baltimore County in the 2024 general election, the Baltimore County Council will expand from seven members to nine members, beginning with the 2026 election; and

WHEREAS, Bill 47-24, which initiated the 2024 ballot question, contained several technical updates to the Charter based on Council expansion, such as increasing the membership on the Board of Appeals and Planning Board to accommodate nine council appointees; and

WHEREAS, while the intent of Bill 47-24 was to include all necessary changes to board and commission memberships in the Charter, an increase to the membership of the Charter Review Commission was inadvertently not included; now therefore

1           SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that under the authority granted to it by Section 1202 of the Baltimore  
3 County Charter, Section 1203(a) of Article XII – Manner of Terminating this Charter and  
4 Making Amendments Thereto of the Baltimore County Charter is proposed to be repealed and  
5 re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

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7           Article XII – Manner of Terminating this Charter and Making Amendments Thereto

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9           Sec. 1203. Charter review commission.

10           (a) A decennial Charter review commission shall be appointed by the county council and  
11 county executive by March 1 in the seventh year of each decade. The Charter review  
12 commission shall be established, by resolution, and be composed of [eleven] THIRTEEN  
13 members who must be residents of the county, with one member appointed by each council  
14 member and two appointed by the county executive. A person who holds elective office is not  
15 eligible for appointment to the commission. The county attorney shall be an ex officio member  
16 of the commission. The chairperson of the county council shall appoint an additional member to

1     serve as the chairperson of the commission.

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3             SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that pursuant to Section 1202 of the  
4     Baltimore County Charter, the question of whether or not the Charter is to be amended as  
5     proposed by this Act shall be submitted to the voters of Baltimore County at the general election  
6     on November 3, 2026, and that this Act shall be published in at least two newspapers of general  
7     circulation in the County for five successive weeks prior to the election.

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9             SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that upon ratification by the voters of  
10     Baltimore County, this Act shall become effective from and after the thirtieth day following the  
11     2026 general election.
