A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Miscellaneous Provisions and Offenses – Dangerous Weapons Prohibited

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the sale, purchase, trade, acquisition, use, carrying or possession of certain dangerous weapons, including metal knuckles and switchblade knives; establishing that any person who violates such prohibition is guilty of misdemeanor and may be subject to a fine, imprisonment, or both; and generally relating the prohibition of dangerous weapons.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County shall read as follows:

7 § 17-2-105. DANGEROUS WEAPONS PROHIBITED.

8 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL, PURCHASE, TRADE, ACQUIRE IN ANY
9 MANNER, USE, CARRY, OR POSSESS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING DANGEROUS
10 WEAPONS:

11 (1) METAL KNUCKLES; OR

12 (2) A KNIFE WITH AN AUTOMATIC SPRING OR OTHER DEVICE FOR
13 OPENING OR CLOSING THE BLADE, COMMONLY KNOWN AS A SWITCHBLADE
14 KNIFE.

15 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY
16 OF A MISDEMEANOR, AND, ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT
17 EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING ONE YEAR OR BOTH.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
20 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect 14 days from the
21 date of enactment.
