ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2025-2026 Current Expense Budget
Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund
Perinatal Care Coordination Infrastructure

FOR the purpose of amending the 2025-2026 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the
Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from federal funds made
available to the County through the Maryland Department of Health.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Health has made an award of federal funds to
the Baltimore County Department of Health and Human Services, to be used for Perinatal Care
Coordination Infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County
Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2015, as amended, the County
Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue

Fund and expend the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of accounting for certain monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for restricted purposes; and

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

2(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County
2015, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30,
be and is hereby amended by appropriating federal funds made available to the Baltimore
y Department of Health and Human Services, in the amount herein specified, to the

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect February 15, 2026.
