A RESOLUTION to authorize the County to accept a donation of five Delta coolers from the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center as a way to expedite the startup of the whole blood program in Baltimore County Fire Department, EMS Division.

WHEREAS, the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center has offered a quantity of five Delta coolers for the whole blood initiative to the County as a gift, provided this resolution is approved; and

WHEREAS, the estimated value of \$24,500 includes five Delta ICE 2L Smart Blood Cooler with a list price of \$4,899.99 each; and

WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Baltimore County Charter vests in the County Council the power to accept gifts and grants; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the County be and is hereby authorized to accept the gift of five Delta Coolers from the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
