Baltimore County Council Announces Modified Work Session Schedule Beginning February 10, 2026

Towson, MD – The Baltimore County Council announced today that it will adhere to a modified Work Session schedule beginning on Tuesday, February 10, 2026 and continuing through the summer.

With the expansion of the County Council from seven Councilmembers to nine, the Council Chamber and other areas of the Council offices are undergoing renovations. These renovations will begin following the Council's Legislative Session on February 2, 2026. From that date until at least through the summer of 2026, the Council Chamber will be unavailable for use, including for Work Sessions and Legislative Sessions.

During this period, the Council's Legislative Sessions will be held at 6:00 p.m. in the Planning Board Hearing Room located on the first floor of the Jefferson Building, 105 West Chesapeake Avenue, Towson, MD 21204.

The Council's Work Sessions each month will be held alternately in-person in the Council's second floor conference room and virtually via WebEx video teleconference.

“We are very excited at the prospect of having two additional members join the County Council. But, unfortunately, this change also means that over the next eight months, we will be in the midst of a renovation that requires changing how and where we hold our meetings in the short term,” said Council Chairman Mike Ertel. “We are trying to keep disruptions to the Council’s meetings and routine at a minimum, while also making sure the public can continue to engage and participate in the legislative process moving forward.”
